DEVELOPMENTS NEAR DIXIE SPRINGS


The planning and zoning commission had the following on their agenda:

Consideration possible recommendation to the City Council on a zoning map change request from RA-I Residential Agricultural I acre, to PDO/R-I-I0, Planned Development Overlay/ Single Family Residential for 240 acres located south of 3000 South and east of Sand Hollow Road immediately west of the proposed Copper Rock annexation area - Toquerville Enterprises applicants; Brant Tuttle agent

If you take Sand Hollow Road south past the entrance

to Sand Hollow and follow it around the reservoir, it turns right onto 3000 South. The map of the area is shown below. The minutes have not been posted so we do not know if the development was approved.

There is another proposed development east of that one. This is the golf course development discussed in the last newsletter. This proposed development is hoping to be annexed by Hurricane so Hurricane can provide the septic they need. Their plan is to have a large housing community with a large section consisting of nightly rentals.

DIXIE SPRINGS COMMUNITY FUND

I have established a Dixie Springs Community Fund. The fund would be used for the following:

- Fight threats to our residential community by establishing a relationship with a lawyer who can provide council and other representation
- Fund the Dixie Springs Community Web Site
- Fund the email messages (free now but there is a cost once we get to a certain size).

No funds would be used without approval of a committee of community members.

The fund will **not** be used to enforce CC&RS.

The money for the fund would come from voluntary donations. We recommend \$100 per year per home,

but any amount is welcome. Any use of the money will be reported in the newsletter. We need to start building the fund now. If we are forced into a lawsuit, the cost could well be over \$20K.

To contribute to the fund, put your donation into the following account at the Mountain America Credit Union: 9992856. Put your name and lot number or address as a memo on the deposit so I can credit you with the donation.

You could set up a \$10 a month automatic deposit into the account, if that would be easier.

Please help your community. You may not be impacted by some of the threats now, but you may be in the future and will be glad of the support of your neighbors and the fund. Let's all work together!

BURNING SEASON

Spring Burn season is March 1 through May 30th and Fall Burn season is September 15 through November 15 2017.
